Venue

- Please arrive at the venue for **09:00**.
- For registration in the morning please arrive at the **Princes Street entrance**, which is at the back of Regent Hall. There is a map below.
- Rehearsals will start at **09:30** and will last all day.
- The show starts at **19:30** and will end approximately between **22:30** and **22:45**. We will aim to finish as close to **22:30** as possible.
- Audience members should arrive at **19:00**.
- The audience should enter through the oxford street entrance at the front of the building.
- There is a small café in Regent Hall, as well as lots of places to buy food and drink along Oxford Street.

What to bring

- Any medication you may need – especially Epi Pens – please bring **two**, so we can leave one with your Head Chaperone. Make sure they are clearly **labelled** with your name.
- Comfy clothes for rehearsing in – no tight jeans, low slung trousers or skirts in the rehearsal room.
- Soft/rubber soled shoes – sneakers or jazz shoes.
- Water bottle.
- Spending money or a packed lunch **and** dinner.
- Please bring your **YMT T-SHIRT**.
- Please bring your instrument if you are an instrumentalist.
- If you can please bring a Christmas jumper.
- You might be asked to bring / prepare more by the practitioners in charge of your segment. We will distribute this information by email and via the Facebook groups if needed.
- You have also been sent music that will be sung during the finale. **Please familiarise yourselves with this before rehearsals.**

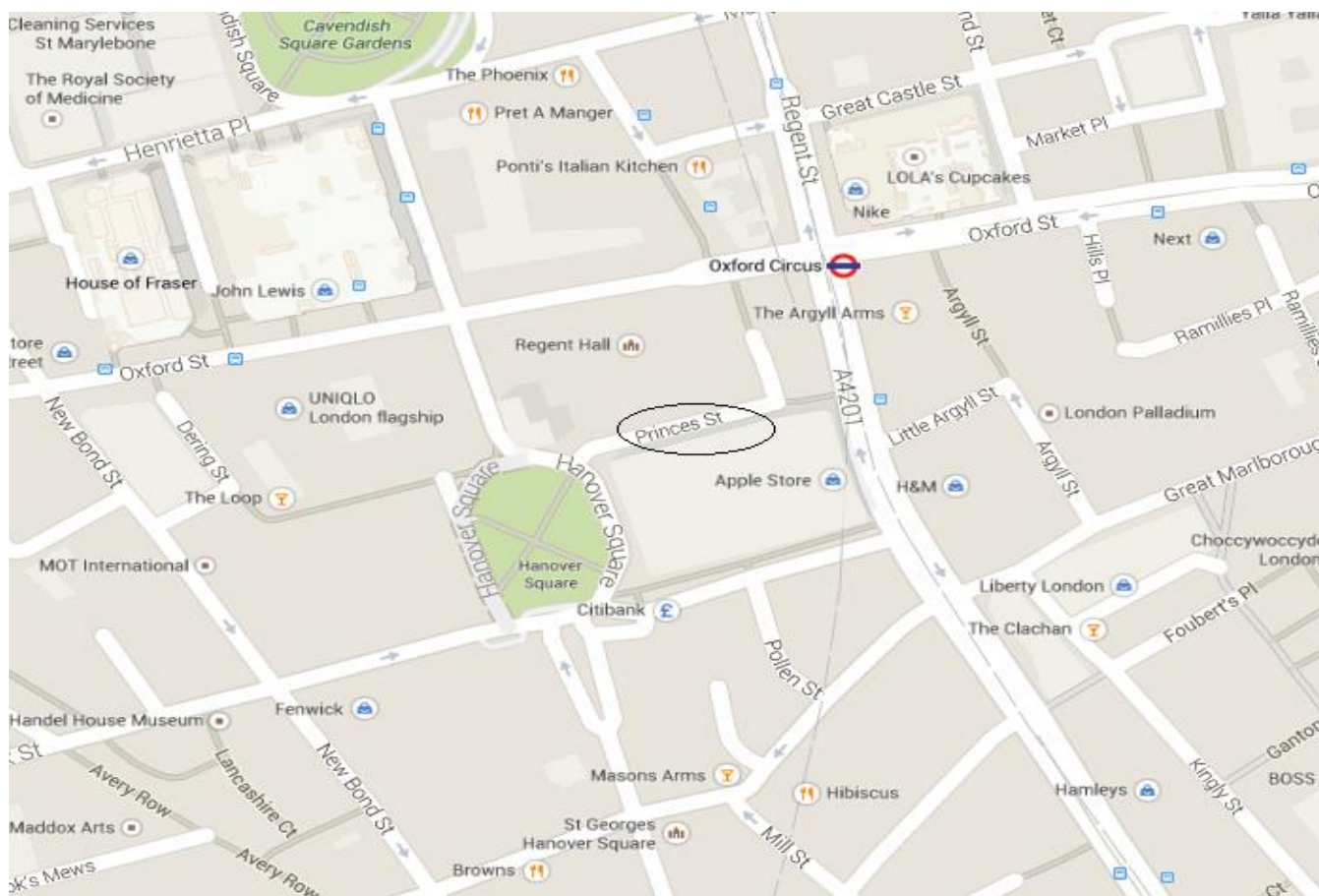
