WELCOME

Welcome to the final show of the BYMT 2023 season! We are so delighted to have opened and closed the season at The Birmingham Hippodrome, a new partner for us, where the wonderful staff share our passion for creating new musicals and engaging young people as collaborators and creative inventors. I first heard about the brilliant idea of #50Days in 2019 at a new musical pitching session and then I was part of a panel finding new shows for development with Royal & Derngate Northampton, China Plate, MMD & MTN and Birmingham Hippodrome in 2022. At this point it was clear that a large company of young people could help the piece to move forwards and when BYMT's Young Company Panel met to shape the 2023 season they agreed it should be included; they wanted a range of music styles in the programme, along with stories that empower young people to find their voice and collective identity.

At a time when performing arts are being taken out of regular school activity and access to creative opportunities denied, it is vital for charities such a BYMT to be listening to young people, engaging their creativity and giving them a platform. In our 2023 Young Company, more than quarter of the performers are from backgrounds currently underrepresented in UK society. We hope you hear what our Young Company want to say about the historical 50 days and their relevance to now, as well as enjoying their glorious performances.

A NOTE FROM THABO STUCK

Why Grime?

Grime is the modern soundtrack of this nation. Like Jungle, Ska and Punk, it represents the underdogs and fuses diverse cultures and experiences. Grime emerged from East London, which is the setting for much of the radical thinking that emerged during the mid 17th Century. There are comparisons to be made between the messages in grime and the thoughts of those who felt marginalised across Britain in 1641, which is where our story begins.

Why the Civil War?

The outcomes are still with us. Many see it as an English fight between King and Parliament, but it goes well beyond that. It's a conflict that spans every echelon of society and corner of Britain. The parallels between the two periods are eerily comparable – In #50Days, we find ourselves in the winter of 1641 and Britain is a nation divided along religious, political and class lines. We are considering our relationship with Europe, the future of the monarchy and all of this whilst London, the epicentre of this piece, is being ravaged by a plague.

Having the opportunity to showcase the developments of this piece with a 30+ strong cast of young people feels perfect for *#50Days*. We have an exciting cast from across the UK, as well as international performers. Many of the cast members are new to the genre and learning certain skills for the first time.

The creative team is a combination of people I have worked with before and some who are new to the project. Mostly, we are a collection of eccentrics who have somehow come together, again from various backgrounds and cultures. #50Days is not just the voice of one person but a whole catalogue of UK talent.

Taking the show to Birmingham feels appropriate, given the exciting grime scene that has been developing in Birmingham for quite some time. It is such a buzzing city and I want to thank everyone for their warm welcome and hospitality across this period. I also want to thank my son Roman for sharing me with this project and Elaine Nelson... because she made me do it x

CREATIVES

THABO STUCK - WRITER

#50DAYS is the debut show from writer Thabo Stuck. Born in South London to parents of South African and German descent, Thabo has spent ten years working in education, most of which as a history teacher in London. For seven of those years Thabo worked at the BRIT School for Performing Arts. Thabo now steps into the creative industry himself, with a show that combines two of his most prominent passions - history and music. 50Davs first featured at MT Fest in 2021 to much excitement, where it was described as "A hurtling exploration of politics and revolution. Shrewdly spiked with references to privilege, Brexit and Fake News". (Sam Marlowe, inews). In 2022 Thabo was awarded a place on the MT Darkroom writing residency at the Royal Derngate in Northampton, supported by China Plate. Earlier this year, Thabo pitched #50Days at BEAM at the Oxford playhouse, to much positive response and excitement.

NYASHA GUDO - DIRECTOR

Nyasha has directed on a range of projects at various subsidised and west end theatres across the country from the Chichester Festival Theatre, National Theatre, Birmingham Repertory Theatre and The RSC. Most recently Nyasha has directed a co production between Headlong Theatre and Belgrade Theatre of A Play for the Living in a Time of Extinction and was associate director on Spitting Image Live at the Birmingham Repertory.

NADINE ROSE JOHNSON - MUSICAL DIRECTOR

Nadine Rose Johnson, is a professional Performance Artist, Writer, Vocal Composer and Facilitator from South London. Recognised for her critically acclaimed gig theatre show *"Frankenstein: How To* Make A Monster" which she co-wrote, co-composed and starred in, Nadine Rose is an international multi-award winning performer (Total Theatre Award, OFFIES, Adelaide Fringe First), has raised thousands of pounds for local charities, and co-ordinates arts programs for children and young people. Nadine Rose also directs vocal projects at top UK drama schools. Melody Sinclair studied Urban Dance Practice at the University of East London (UEL). Alongside her studies, she became a member of ZooNation Dance Company and trained with Boy Blue Entertainment. Melody's choreographer credits include: Choreographer of Unfortunate: The Untold Story of the Sea Witch (UK Tour), Choreographer of Treasure Island (Hall for Cornwall), Associate Choreographer on To The Streets (Birmingham Hippodrome/ China Plate Productions) and Co-Founder of Marshon Dance Company (Birmingham).
