# A NOTE FROM CARL MILLER AND LUKE SAYDON

There was a real Orphan Train – lots of them, transporting 250,000 children in the United States between the 1850s and the 1920s, away from the streets of more crowded (and supposedly more sinful) cities to rural locations considered physically and spiritually healthier.

Although some motivation for this was genuine distress at the terrible effects of poverty on children, the attitudes behind it were patronising, stereotyping and racist in their convictions about what made good and bad environments for young people. And there was little oversight to protect children from being placed in families who exploited and abused them. Similar movements transported children from their homes in this country too. In 2010 the UK government apologised for the effects of the historic Child Migrants Programme here.

From research into the experiences of children paraded for selection at each Orphan Train stop, composer Luke Saydon was inspired to imagine The Naughty Carriage – where children who are not chosen end up. Director Emily Gray and co-writer Carl Miller joined him in the development of this show celebrating the energy and potential of rebels and misfits - children not fitting stereotypes of the 'deserving poor'.

There are many significant orphan characters in music theatre: Tristan, the Pirates of Penzance (their weak spot being that they will never attack a fellow orphan), Billy Budd, Hamilton, Annie... Not to mention plenty of orphan-adjacent characters like Oliver, who believe they have no parents. There is rich dramatic potential in the gap between the compassionate rhetoric often expressed for parentless children and their actual experience of neglect and exploitation. We have been inspired by the stories of looked-after children in the development of the show, whether as participants in workshops on earlier drafts, or the older choir member whose life and work inspired the idea of The Bear Who Drinks Tears.

# **CREATIVES**

#### LUKE SAYDON - COMPOSER, CO-LYRICIST & MUSICAL DIRECTOR

Working with organisations including British Youth Musical Theatre, The Old Vic, V&A Museum, Les Enfants Terribles, Museum of London and The British Library, Luke has been the musical director for Chickenshed Theatre Company in Kensington & Chelsea, Some Voices and Wyllyotts Theatre. His musical HUSH premiered at the Malta National Theatre as part of the Valletta European City of Culture in 2018. The production went on to win three Maltese National Arts Awards: Best Production, Best Work for Young Audiences and Best Young Artist Award. His latest work The Naughty Carriage on the Orphan Train was part of BEAM2021 at the Hackney Empire, the UK's leading showcase of new British musical theatre. Other writing and composition credits include Mv Wav Home (Royal College of Music, Britten Theatre), Dreams of Freedom (Royal Albert Hall), HARVEY MILK (Zedels, London), Heart to Heart (Musical Podcast) Polly & Ester (Żigużają), Dear Future Me (Battersea Arts Centre), The Indispensable Hero (Chelsea Theatre), The Changing Room (UK National Theatre Connections Festival), Trumpets & Raspberries (Chickenshed), Tales from the Shed (Old Vic), V&A Pink Floyd Exhibition (V&A Museum), The Theatre of the Pitied (Malta tour), The Indispensable Hero (The Lyric Theatre), The Story of Stories (The Lyric Theatre), Ernest & The Pale Moon (Malta Society of Arts) and The Three Sunsets (National Theatre of Malta). Luke is the founder of Savdon Studio a new theatre collective that makes and shares new musical theatre within communities.

#### **CARL MILLER - WRITER & CO-LYRICIST**

Carl Miller originally trained as a director at the Royal Court on the Regional Theatre Young Director Scheme. He has been Artistic Director of the Royal Court Young People's Theatre, an Associate Director of Birmingham Rep and Unicorn, and Writer in Residence at the Theatre Royal Bury St Edmunds. Carl has devised many playwriting projects with

young people and adults and with the Royal Court International Department has worked with new playwrights in Brazil, China, India and Uganda. He is a member of Mercury Musical Developments' Advanced Writers' Lab. Carl Miller's book and lyric writing for music theatre includes Wasted and Lucky Petra (both composed by Christopher Ash) Yarico (London Theatre Workshop), A Little Princess (The Other Palace) and White Suit (Greenwich and Docklands International Festival). His plays include Emil and the Detectives (National Theatre) and Ostrich Boys (Belgrade Coventry and National Theatre Company of Korea).

#### **EMILY GRAY - DIRECTOR**

Emily has been the Creative Director of BYMT since May2022 and before that was Executive Director of Mercury Musical Developments, a charity that supports new music theatre writers. Her career has been in directing new work with and for young people, including 15 years as Artistic Director of Trestle Theatre Company, an internationally renowned mask and physical theatre company. She was Artistic Director of TAG in Glasgow and Associate Director of Unicorn Theatre in London. Directing credits include Frankenstein, complete with Virtual Reality, for the National Youth Theatre and a musical adaptation of A Little Princess at The Other Palace. She has worked continually in schools, delivering workshops, training drama & music teachers, creating new projects, such as a half mask version of The Strange Case of Dr Jekyll & Mr Hyde and the new musical Yarico. Emily trained as a director at Royal Central School of Speech & Drama and on the Regional Theatre Young Directors' Scheme at Nottingham Playhouse.

#### **ASH MUKHERJEE - CHOREOGRAPHER**

Born in Kolkata, India, Ash trained in Bharatanatyam at Kalamandalam Kolkata with Guru Smt Thankamani Kutty. He pursued ballet with Lady Doreen Wells from the Royal Ballet and earned a BA (hons) in Jazz Theatre Dance from London Studio Centre. Acclaimed by Dance Europe Magazine as one of the finest Indian classical dancers in the UK, Ash was hand picked by the This Is It! team, to dance a duet with Michael Jackson at London's O2 Arena. Ash starred on BBC 3's Move Like Michael Jackson and created with choreographer Lavelle Smith Junior a solo integrating Indian classical dance with Michael's iconic hit Man In The Mirror, broadcast to three million viewers. Choreographic works include BBC 2's Royal Wedding Duet for So You Think You Can Dance UK, Katie Melua/William Orbit's The Flood video, and British Youth Music Theatre's Educating Yorkshire T'Musical. Awards include Outstanding Male Dancer Critics' Circle National Dance Awards UK nominee, Time Out London Rising Talent, and Critics' Choice artist by Dance Europe. As an actor Ash has appeared in TNT's Will, Marvel's The Eternals, and HBO's House Of Dragon. His one-person show Vishnu's Got My Back, delving into mental health from post-colonial Kolkata to London, premiered Birmingham Roval Conservetoire, followed by a 2022 UK tour. Ash currently serves as Movement Director for The Citizens of the World Refugee Choir, performing at the Queens Platinum Jubilee Party at Buckingham Palace and Glastonbury 2022.

#### **CLAIRE NICOLL - DESIGNER**

Claire is a recent graduated in Technical Theatre from Edinburgh College specialising in set and prop design. She is now their Artist in Residence, working alongside staff to engage and inspire current students. Claire has also worked for a number of years in the costume department for many theatre productions and films including The West End Production of Grease 2023 (the Dominium) The Lion King (2022/23 UK tour), Educating Rita (Perth Theatre), Mary and George (Hera pictures LTD) Good Omens 2 (nice and accurate productions), Memory Spinners (Scottish Opera), Singing and Rainbows (Perth Festival of the Arts).
