We are so delighted to be opening at **The Birmingham Hippodrome**, a new partner for us, where the wonderful staff share our passion for creating new musicals and engaging young people as collaborators and creative inventors. **Our Girls Our Game** was originally devised in 2021 and performed in Yorkshire. Following the huge success of the Lionesses in 2022, we wanted to give new life to this story of girls and women supporting each other, fighting for independence and celebrating their individuality.

BYMT has a Young Company Panel who helped to shape the 2023 season and they wanted this show to be developed and recreated for a new audience. The panel set the season theme as young people finding their tribe and a collective voice and Our Girls Our Game fulfils this, perfectly with the lyric:

You'll find what's important's Not glory or wealth It's the family you choose for yourself

Over the past two weeks, a dedicated team of professional female creative, pastoral and technical staff have worked together with female and non-binary performers and musicians, aged between 12 and 21, to make this show; we have welcomed performers from the Ukraine, Germany and South Africa, as well as all over the UK and Ireland. A NOTE FROM VICTORIA SAXTON, VIKKI STONE, CHARLOTTE WESTENRA AND JANE MCMURTRIE

The Dick, Kerr Ladies F.C. team were the A list celebrities of their day. They were featured on magazine covers, Pathé films and their matches sold out venues such as Stamford Bridge. One of their players, Lilly Parr, scored more goals in her lifetime than Lionel Messi and Cristiano Ronaldo combined! But why have you never heard of them? In short the F.A were threatened by their success. It seems fitting, therefore, that our brilliant director, Charlotte Westenra, brought together an all-female creative team to tell this story and insisted on an all-female & non-binary cast.

We wrote the first draft of **Our Girls, Our Game** in under two weeks, with the collaboration of 30 BYMT members in 2021. The words and music were inspired as much by the passion of the BYMT girls, as by the Dick, Kerr team themselves. Most musicals take five to ten years to write, so two weeks was quite the feat! We've had some developmental time since then and the 2023 cohort of BYMT actors have blown us away with their talent, grit and determination. But you, the audience, are the final collaborator. We welcome your feedback and help in telling the world about the mighty Dick, Kerr Ladies F.C. This is a story that belongs to any girl, or person, who faces and overcomes oppression to realise their dreams.

VICTORIA SAXTON - BOOKWRITER

Victoria Saxton is a writer & dramaturg with an expertise in new musical theatre. She is currently working on several TV feature films for Reel One Ents, alongside a children's musical using the music of CBeebies star Nick Cope for the North Wall Theatre/ David Luff Productions, alongside a book about the dramaturgy of new musicals for Bloomsbury Publishing. Select writing credits include: Lyrics for Fragments (Playground Theatre, London & Oxford) several commissions for Big Finish Productions, including Bernice Summerfield Adventures and ATA Girl – Flying with a Spitfire (BBC Audio Award Finalist), Head of the Table with drama desk nominee Paul Castles (Young Vic Labs) and Marriage a la Mode with Charles Miller (Chichester University). call Her dramaturgy clients her 'musical whisperer' and range the across Broadway, Off Broadway and UK touring producers and writers. Victoria was Executive Director of Mercury Musical Developments (2015-2019) co-creating and producing BEAM the UK's largest showcase of New British Musical Theatre along various other new writing initiatives.

VIKKI STONE - MUSIC & LYRICS / MUSIC SUPERVISOR

Vikki Stone is an award-winning writer, composer, comedian and musician. Writing credits include: co-adapter, writer and music supervisor for the Oliver Award winning *Hey Duggee Live*, #zoologicalsociety for Royal & Derngate, *Cinderella & Aladdin* for The Lyric Hammersmith, *Ten Pieces Special Report* for BAFTA Nominated children's music series BBC Ten Pieces, *Our Girls Our Game* for British Youth Music Theatre and *Alice In Wonderland*, which is heading to The Liverpool Everyman and Theatre Royal Plymouth in summer 2023. Vikki made history when she was the musical director, pianist and band leader of the Saturday night ITV prime-time show *Romeo and Duet*, making her the first on-screen female musical director of a primetime entertainment show in the UK. Other TV appearances include: *BBC Proms* coverage for BBC Four, *Romeo and Duet*, Richard Osman's *House of Games*, *Celebrity Pointless*, *The Dog Ate My Homework*, *The John Bishop Show*, *Partners in Rhyme* and the BAFTA award-winning *Ten Pieces* for BBC.

CHARLOTTE WESTENRA - DIRECTOR

Charlotte is a stage director and dramaturg specialising in political theatre and new writing, with an emphasis on the development of British musicals. Her production Agreement by Owen McCafferty is currently on at the Lyric Theatre Belfast for the 25th Anniversary of the signing of the Good Friday Agreement. Her upcoming work includes Sin a one woman musical satire by Richard Hough and Ben Morales Frost for the Barn Theatre, Cirencester. She is currently developing a contemporary political musical with composer Ruth Chan and lyricist Darren Clark; a guirky British romantic comedy with writers Bateman, Hughes & Conley and a children's crime caper with composer, lyricist Jonny Berliner with a libretto by Rhys Jennings. Abeda specializes in designing and making costumes for theatre and dance companies, with an impressive list of commissions.
