## A NOTE FROM VICTORIA GARTNER

There is a reason why we keep telling the same stories. Some stories have such a deepseated hold on our collective imagination that we cannot help but keep sharing them, seeking them and marvelling in them. Shakespeare's Romeo and Juliet is undoubtedly one of those stories. Shakespeare himself was a great borrower, inspiring himself from a story he read in Matteo Bandello's Novelle (1554), which the Italian himself borrowed from another compatriot, Luigi da Porto. Indeed, almost all of the Bard's work has its origins in earlier tales or passages of history. After all, he had to cater to the voracious demands of Elizabethan theatre-goers, which meant he needed to write a lot of good material, and fast. But he made some consequent changes to the tale, for instance the lovers meeting and dving within a few days as opposed to several months, and the invention of the character of Mercutio – a nod, perhaps, to his contemporary Christopher Marlowe and a great life cut short. Our Romeo and Juliet musical honours this tradition. Retaining at its core the story and words of the Bard, the songs tell of young people's hopes and dreams for a better future, of leaving the world a better place than you found it. If there is one thing this story teaches us, one thing we must hear today, is that war will only ever lead to greater tragedies and that it is never too late to make peace. We owe it to future generations. We have set this tale here in Plymouth by the sea, in a colourful world that is urgent and harsh, where the cries of seagulls mix with those of feral youths in long summer days. So, welcome to our Verona. We hope you're here to stay.

## VICTORIA GARTNER - WRITER & DIRECTOR

Victoria Gartner is an award-nominated writer and director, whose work has been produced in the UK, Switzerland, Germany and the Netherlands. Her latest project, Bard in the Yard, has been performed across the UK to great public and critical acclaim for the past few years, and has Dame Helen Mirren as patron. Other work by Victoria includes A Midsummer Night's Dream (British Youth Music Theatre), Will or Eight Lost Years of William Shakespeare's Life (Rose Playhouse, European tour), Verona (Theatre tri-bühne, Stuttgart). She is currently Assistant Director on Agatha Christie's And Then There Were None, directed by Lucy Bailey, touring the UK until 2024. Previous Assistant Director credits include The Comedy of Errors, Three Sisters, Twelfth Night, and operas Acis & Galatea, Teenage Bodies, Snow White (Switzerland). Victoria has been teaching Shakespeare at LAMDA, East15 and the Shakespeare Birthplace Trust. She was born in Ukraine and grew up in the French-speaking part of Switzerland before moving to the UK. She has an MA in English literature with a specialisation in Shakespearean studies as well as a degree in Dramaturgy and Directing, and is the Artistic Director of Will & Co.

#### JUDE OBERMÜLLER - COMPOSER, ORCHESTRATOR & MUSICAL DIRECTOR

Jude Obermüller is a British musician, most often composing for Theatre and Recorded Media, living in New York. He was a full scholar at both London's Royal College of Music, and NYU's Tisch School of the Arts. In 2021, he became a fellow of the Johnny Mercer Songwriters' Project. Jude's scores include: *Beauty & the Seven Beasts* (The Opera Story, London - Fedora Prize runnerup); Julius Caesar (Singapore Rep); As You Like *it & Farragut North* (Southwark Playhouse, Off West End); Alice in Wonderland (Storyhouse, UK regional); Underground (59E59 Off Broadway); UCAS & The Jabberwocky (Edinburgh Festival); I remember the ship (Tête à Tête). Music for screen includes commercials for Vogue; musical sketches for Comedy Central; and various independent films, most recently the tap-dance led short DATELEAP (with director/choreographer Jack Evans and lyricist David Gomez), which is currently playing film festivals all over the world. Current musical works: Miss Havisham's Wedding (with David Gomez & Laura Barati); Feet Keep Me Flyin' (with Jack Evans & David Gomez) Bardo: A Musical Webseries.

## DAVID GOMEZ - LYRICIST & SONGWRITER

David Gomez is a lyricist, librettist, and songwriter. With Jude Obermuller, David has collaborated on *The Blue Shoes*, *Miss Havisham's Wedding*, and *Feet Keep Me Flyin'*. The Stiles & Drewe "Best New Song" Prize honored their song, "Silver" in 2018, and they joined the Johnny Mercer Songwriting Workshop in 2021. David's theatre work has received support and recognition from The Dramatist Guild, American Playwriting Foundation, and the Musical Theatre Factory. As a proud Chicano, David is part of a long tradition of corridistas who used popular song forms to build community, create revolutions, and connect the past to the present.

#### **KATHERINE MORAN - CHOREOGRAPHER**

Katherine is a British-Irish actor, choreographer, writer and voiceover artist. She attended her first local dance class in Pinner aged four and went on to train on the prestigious BA Acting course at the Royal Central School of Speech & Drama. She combines her dance technique and acting experience within her movement and choreography work, most recently for productions at the Cockpit, Brighton Fringe and Holroyd Theatre. In acting, Katherine has over a decade's experience across TV, film, UK and international theatre. Credits include: *Call The Midwife* (BBC), *The B@it* (Channel 4), *A Christmas Gift From Bob* (Lionsgate), *News Revue* (BBC/Canal Cafe Theatre). When she's not running around a rehearsal room, Katherine runs her voiceover business from her professional home studio. Recent projects include: *Cassette Beasts* (Xbox/Nintendo), commercials for Vrbo, Moonpig, House of Fraser, and voiceover for HSBC, Superdrug, and European Commission. Katherine's first play, Ruthless, is currently in development with Masterclass.

#### **LU HERBERT - DESIGNER**

Lu Herbert is a freelance Set and Costume Designer based in the North of England. They have a creative practice that embraces sustainability, vibrancy and play. Collaboration is a core facet of their design process. Lu has both a BA from the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland in Set and Costume Design, and an MA in Collaborative Theatre Production and Design from Guildhall School of Music and Drama.
