CHRISTOPHER TENDAI - CREATIVE DIRECTOR & CHOREOGRAPHER

Christopher Tendai is an Award Winning Theatre Choreographer, breathing a fresh new life into the imagery of how we see Theatre and Dance productions. Some of his credits include: BYMT's Harry & Greta, Closer To Heaven -(Offies Nominated for Best Choreography 2024), Wuthering Heights A New Musical Workshop, Children of Eden, Carrie The Musical, The Guap Gala at the Natural History Museum, and Wonderland In Alice (Offies Finalist for Best Choreography). "Within my body of work, I like to lead with 'intention' first and then allow the movement to follow. In my opinion I feel that 'narrative' is the fundamental aspect of creating powerful movement." DENZEL WESTLEY-SANDERSON - CO-DIRECTOR

Denzel is an award-winning Theatre Director and workshop facilitator based in London. He trained at Mountview Academy of Theatre Arts, completing the MA Theatre Directing course in 2017. Following his graduation, Denzel was part of the resident directors' pool at the Almeida Theatre from 2017-2018. Denzel's portfolio spans various genres and styles, including New Writing, Musicals, Opera, Devising, and Dance Theatre. He has notably collaborated with the CTC Dance Company, directing their show Identity, which won the award for 'Exciting New Work' at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival. Denzel co-directed Jesus Christ Superstar - The Concert at Regent's Park Open

Air Theatre during the pandemic and was the Associate Director on *Dick Whittington* at the National Theatre. He returned to the National Theatre in 2022 as the Associate Director on *Small Island*. Denzel was awarded the RTST Sir Peter Hall Director Award and directed the critically acclaimed UK tour of *The Importance of Being Earnest*, produced by ETT, Leeds Playhouse, and the Rose Theatre Kingston. Additionally, he was nominated for Best Director at the Stage Debut Awards and the Black British Theatre Awards in 2023. Denzel was the Sky Arts Associate Artist at Theatre Royal Stratford East and directed their annual pantomime in December 2023.

MEG MCGRADY - COMPOSER

Accidental purple person, Meg McGrady (they/them) is a neurodivergent nonbinary musical theatre creative having worked as a composer, producer, writer and performer. Driven, collaborative, and a vocal activist, Meg studied Musical Theatre at the BRIT School and Theatre and Social Change at Rose Bruford. Having tackled shows about the race to discover the structure of DNA to young queer kids learning how to protest against their catholic school, Meg has worked on a vast range of new theatre pieces as a writer and composer including the award-winning The Phase (VAULT Festival), 'iNk'd' (CTC Dance), The Planet Is ______ (Other Palace/Theatre Deli), and the upcoming Wonderland In Alice (Octagon Bolton). Other work-in-progress shows include I found you a cool rock, Rosalind, and Virgin.

NADINE-ROSE JOHNSON - MUSICAL DIRECTOR

Nadine Rose Johnson is a Musical Director, Vocal Artist, Actor, writer and Vocal Tutor from South East London. Nadine has written for, vocally composed for and performed in several productions nationally and internationally, making their Musical Direction Debut in 2022. Their most notable show, Frankenstein: How To Make A Monster, Co-written/composed, won 4 awards and toured internationally, as far as Adelaide, Australia, and was made into a BBC Film. As well as their work in Spoken Word, Music and Theatre, Nadine Rose has raised thousands of pounds for local charities and coordinates and facilitates free arts programs for children, young people and adults, with an emphasis on those from disadvantaged backgrounds. Kritika Agarwal is a Set and Costume Designer from India based in London and soon going to be a Creative Associate at the Belgrade Theatre in Coventry.
