Welcome to BYMT's 20th Anniversary Summer Season. We are delighted to be returning once again to the New Wolsey with our New Music Theatre Award winner; this year it is called Welcome to Serene, a brand new musical conjured up over the past two weeks by a dedicated team of professional adults and a fabulous cast of young people. The Award is given to young writer/composers who are creating their first fully staged musical and in May we spent two days at the New Wolsey with the cast, exploring the script and developing ideas and characters. Young people are involved in deciding which shows BYMT are going to create and they were particularly excited by the challenging yet playful nature of this piece, along with its quirky characters and inspirational music.

#### **BETHANY TENNICK** - COMPOSER, MUSICAL DIRECTOR & LYRICIST

Bethany Tennick (she/they) is an actormusician and composer based in Glasgow. They graduated with a BA in musical theatre from the Royal Conservatoire of Scotland in 2018, and was nominated for Best Performer in a Musical for The Stage in 2020. Recent theatre credits include: Babs (Traverse Theatre & PPP), A Mother's Song (Macrobert Theatre), Land (Gilded Balloon), Jack and the Beanstalk, Sleeping Beauty (Gaiety Theatre), All I Want for Christmas (Macrobert Theatre). Michael Caton-Jones) and short films Bleed and Ghosted (Kick the Door). Bethany composed the score for Babs (PPP) with Morna Young, and the music and lyrics for Thread and Land (Kick the Door). They are currently writing music and Music Directing for Antigone (Perth Youth Theatre) and Beau and the Snow Fairy (PACE).

#### HANNAH BENSON - DIRECTOR

Hannah is a Director and Artistic Director of multi-award winning theatre company Burnt Lemon Theatre. Hannah is passionate about developing innovative new musicals and is thrilled to be developing *Welcome to Serene* with the brilliant emerging

talent at BYMT. Hannah's previous work has been nominated for a WhatsOnStage and Visionary honours award as well as winning the LET Stepladder Award and New Diorama's Untapped Award. #### **ASH MUKHERJEE - CHOREOGRAPHER**

Born in Kolkata, India, Ash trained in Bharatanatyam at Kalamandalam Kolkata with Guru Smt Thankamani Kutty. He pursued ballet with Lady Doreen Wells from the Roval Ballet and earned a BA (hons) in Jazz Theatre Dance from London Studio Centre. Acclaimed by Dance Europe Magazine as one of the finest Indian classical dancers in the UK, Ash was hand picked by the This Is It! team, to dance a duet with Michael Jackson at London's O2 Arena. Ash starred on BBC 3's Move Like Michael Jackson and created with choreographer Lavelle Smith Junior a solo integrating Indian classical dance with Michael's iconic hit Man In The Mirror, broadcast to three million viewers. Choreographic works include BBC 2's Royal Wedding Duet for So You Think You Can Dance UK, Katie Melua/William Orbit's The Flood video. and British Youth Music Theatre's Educating Yorkshire T'Musical and The Naughty Carriage On The Orphan Train. Awards include Outstanding Male Dancer Critics' Circle National Dance Awards UK nominee, Time Out London Rising Talent, and Critics' Choice artist by Dance Europe. As an actor

Ash has appeared in TNT's *Will*, Marvel's *The Eternals*, and HBO's *House Of Dragon*. His one-person show *Vishnu's Got My Back*, delving into mental health from postcolonial Kolkata to London, premiered at Royal Birmingham Conservetoire, followed by a 2022 UK tour. Ash currently serves as Movement Director for The Citizens of the World Refugee Choir, performing at the Queens Platinum Jubilee Party at Buckingham Palace and Glastonbury 2022.

#### **CLAIRE NICOLL - DESIGNER**

Claire Nicoll is a talented designer, currently returning for her second show with British Youth Music Theatre. Having previously designed for last season's acclaimed production of The Naughty Carriage on the Orphan Train, directed by Emily Gray. Claire continues to captivate audiences with her innovative approach to design, connecting viewers to the intricate worlds inhabited by the characters on stage. Most recently, Claire worked in the costume department of Grease in the West End, and on the UK tour of The Lion King showcasing her versatility and skill working across multiple creative disciplines.
