- Please arrive at the venue for **09:00**.
- For registration in the morning please arrive at the **Princes Street entrance**, which is at the **back** of Regent Hall. There is a map below.
- Rehearsals will start at **09:30** and will last all day.
- The show starts at **19:30** and will end approximately between **22:00** and **22:30**. We will aim to finish as close to **22:30** as possible.
- As the show is created during the day it is hard to give an exact finish time so the finishing time of the show is an approximate.
- Doors will open in the evening for audience members at 19:15.
- The audience should enter through the Oxford Street entrance at the front of the building.
- There is a small café in Regent Hall, as well as lots of places to buy food and drink along Oxford Street.

What to bring

- Any medication you may need – especially Epi Pens – please bring **two**, so we can leave one with your Head Chaperone. Make sure they are clearly **labelled** with your name.
- Comfy clothes for rehearsing in – no tight jeans, low slung trousers or skirts in the rehearsal room.

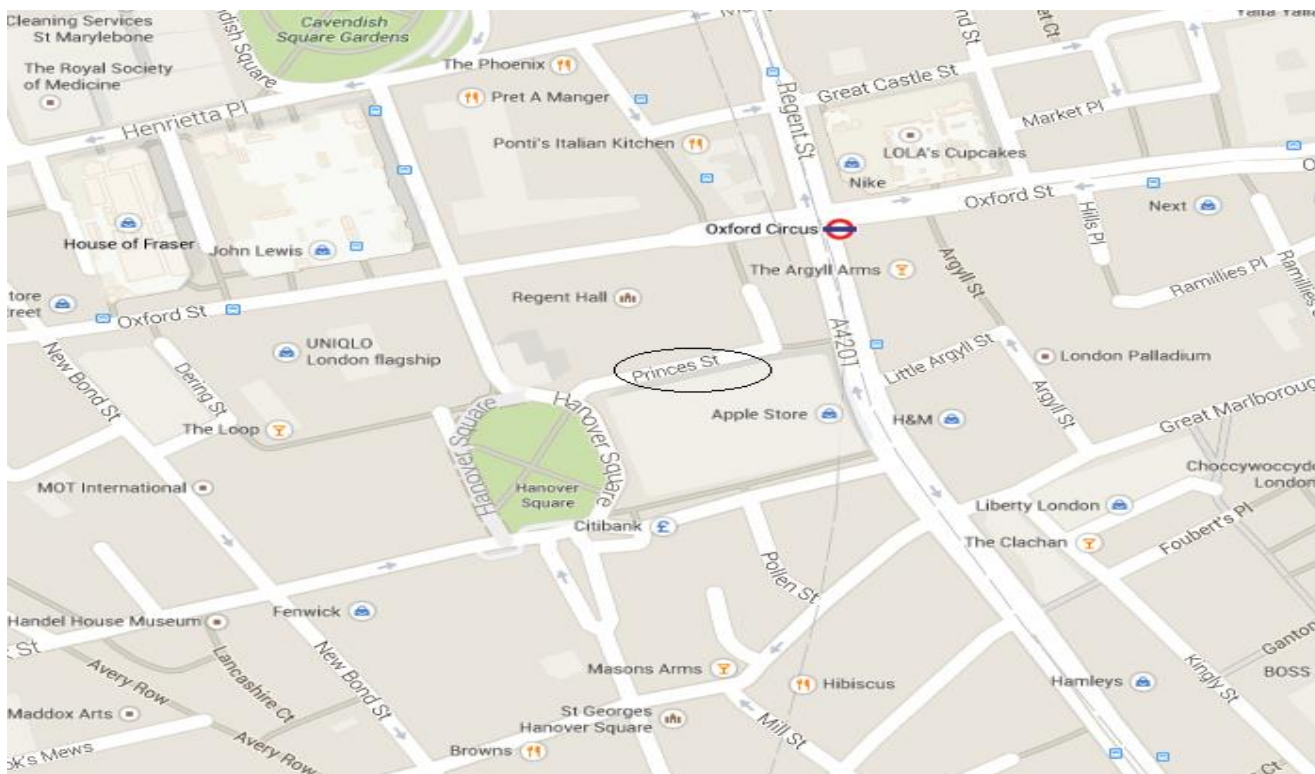
